Jaxen McAdara, junior, McQueen: McAdara was 3-for-3 with three RBIs, a home run and two runs scored in the Lancers' 13-1 win over Damonte Ranch in baseball on March 12.

Zach Dinubilo, senior, Spanish Springs: Dinubilo pitched six innings and allowed one hit with no runs while striking out eight in the Cougars' 1-0 win over Reno in baseball on March 14. Dinubilo has committed to play baseball at Clark College in Washington.

Nico Leonard, junior, Reed: Leonard was 2-for-3 and drove in three runs in the Raiders' 11-6 win over Bishop Manogue in baseball on March 12.

Drew Fairman, junior, Galena: Fairman was 3-for-4 with two RBIs in the Grizzlies' 10-2 win over Damonte Ranch in baseball on March 14. He was 2-for-4 with an RBI in the Grizzlies' 8-5 win over Spanish Springs on March 12. He had three RBIs in a 12-6 win over Damonte on March 16.

Wade Huntsman, sophomore, Bishop Manogue: Huntsman pitched seven innings, allowed two hits and struck out 11 in the Miners' 2-0 win over McQueen in baseball on March 16.

Hannah Fitzpatrick, sophomore, Spanish Springs: Fitzpatrick was 4-for-4 with seven RBIs in the Cougars' 17-2 win over McQueen on softball on Saturday.

Thomas Young, senior, Douglas: Young was 3-for-3 with four RBIs in the Tigers' 15-11 win over Fallon in baseball on March 14.

Mack Edwards, senior, Reno: Edwards was 3-for-4 with five RBIs and two runs scored in the Huskies' 8-1 win over Spanish Springs in baseball on March 16.

Talia Tretton, senior, Douglas: Tretton allowed two hits and drove in two runs in the Tigers' 11-1 win over Reed in softball on March 13. She struck out 10 and allowed two hits

Ava Wulforst, senior, Galena: Wulforst was instrumental in an 11-7 win over Truckee in girls lacrosse on March 12. She had five goals, two assists, five ground balls and three draw controls. She will attend UMass-Lowell on an athletic scholarship. Wulforst was also a three-year varsity basketball player for Galena.
